Mr. Miller:

As per our telephone conversation this morning, I am forwarding the Centerfire, Isleta and Roswell drop zone information we discussed. The following information has been obtained from both the 58th Special Operations Wing and the 377th Civil Engineer Division:

Centerfire drop zone: This drop zone was established in 2006 and is used on a daily basis (M-F). The current activities are similar to those proposed for the EMRTC drop zone EA.

Isleta drop zone: This drop zone was established about 1988 and is used on a daily basis (M-F). The current activities are similar to those proposed for the EMRTC drop zone EA. However, the current agreement with the City of Albuquerque prevents the 58th SOW from conducting personnel or rescue drops at the Isleta drop zone.

Roswell drop zone: Our records indicate that this drop zone was established sometime around February 1989 and is only used 2-3 times per year for personnel drops. Due to logistical and financial reasons, cargo drops are not conducted at this drop zone.

I would also like to thank you for the invitation for Air Force representation at the upcoming City Council mtg. However, as I mentioned in our conversation, it would be inappropriate for an Air Force representative to appear and participate in discussions concerning the EMRTC drop zone EA, in that it is not an Air Force document or an Air Force funded document.
